Before we arrive at Shelter Island, The Perlman Music Program is making a stop in Jerusalem, Israel for an extraordinary musical and cultural opportunity. In partnership with the Jerusalem Music Centre, the residency's two and a half week curriculum will allow students from both countries to collaborate in a supportive, non-competitive environment. Students from The Perlman Music Program will study chamber music, play in orchestra and sing in chorus with their Israeli peers from The Jerusalem Academy and The Buchmann-Mehta School of Music. There will also be six *Works in Progress* Concerts throughout the residency, and plenty of cultural and sight-seeing adventures.
