DAILY RESIDENCY CLOTHING

- Day to day attire should be casual and comfortable. Shorts and Jeans, t-shirts, sneakers and sandals, are encouraged.
- Sweaters, sweatshirts and jackets **are required** weather in Sarasota can get chilly (especially in the evenings).
- Good sneakers are recommended. The hotel does have exercise facilities.
- Swimwear is encouraged for use at the hotel swimming pool.
- Please bring a raincoat and umbrella for rainy days.

CONCERT CLOTHING

- For the final Celebration Concert:
 - Boys: Black pants, black dress shirt, skinny color tie, no jacket
 - Girls: Gown and dress shoes
- *Works in Progress* concert (these are the concerts when you will perform your chamber music, solos, sonatas, and concertos) dress is up to each performer. Most students wear dark pants and dress shirts or suits or colorful blouses/skirts or dresses. You should bring what you would normally feel comfortable wearing for a solo recital performance.

MEDICAL

- Back up bow (if you have one)
